| | Participants will learn to use the tools on the tool bar—for example, the pen, the magic pen, and the eraser. | 3 | SmartBoard: Beyond Basics | 8/2 Tuesday | Kathy Ray & Chuck Knepfle | Free for teachers but you must register |
| | As the name of this workshop suggests, this course takes participants beyond basic SmartBoard techniques into more “advanced” moves. Teachers will learn to use shapes to cover text, to use the recording function and to export presentations for use with other software, and much more. While a short review of Basics is to be expected, we’ll focus on learning and practicing more advanced techniques. Don’t be afraid: you are welcome to sign up for this workshop, even if you have just taken one of the Basics courses on August 1. | | | |
| 4 | SmartBoard Sharing | 8/8 Monday | Kathy Ray | Free for teachers but you must register |
| | This workshop <u>requires that each participant bring with him/her a SmartBoard presentation</u> to be shared with other participants. The presentation can be as simple or as complex as you wish. You are welcome to present a lesson that uses the SmartBoard to enhance student involvement, or one that uses internet resources or educational games to enhance student engagement in the lesson. Depending on the number of participants, we will do all we can to split the group into grade levels. | 5 | SmartBoard & Blogger | 8/9 Tuesday | Kathy Ray & Chuck Knepfle | Free for teachers but you must register |
| | Participants in this class will build a website that will be used all year long to communicate with parents. Basic knowledge of the use of a SmartBoard will be assumed, as participants will be learning how to export Notebook software including recordings, pictures, hyperlinks, and worksheets to their blogs. | | | |
